ALL DOGS NEED TO BE MEASURED

(effective January 1, 2025)

Dogs cannot be officially measured before they are 2 years old, but they must be measured by the time they are competing in Elite.

Measuring will be available Friday at 11:30 and Saturday/Sunday at 7:20 as well as during the day as the judge's time allows.

JUMP HEIGHTS

There are four Standard Division-Proficient jump heights: 8", 12", 16", and 20".

There are four Standard Division-Skilled jump heights: 4", 8", 12", and 16".

There are four jump heights for the Veterans and Junior Handler divisions: 4", 8", 12", and 16".

BRIEF SUMMARY OF RULES

Please refer to www.nadac.com for a full explanation of all NADAC rules and up to date information.

- Please note that NADAC trials should provide a safe and fun environment for both exhibitors and their dogs.
- Aggressive dogs will not be tolerated and will be excused from the trial.
- The show committee has the right to refuse any entry. Anyone not currently in good standing with NADAC will not be allowed to enter this trial.
- Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of NADAC rules and regulations, and agree to abide by all rules in effect at the time of this trial.
- No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reasons of riots, civil disturbances, fire, acts of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- Checks not honored by the bank do not constitute a valid entry fee. There will be a \$25.00 service charge for bank returned checks.
- Dog must be registered and have a valid registration number before entries will be accepted. New Handlers please register here: [NADAC-New Handler-Dog Registration](#). If you already have a dog registered with NADAC or are a NADAC Associate, please visit the H&D Portal to register a new dog.
- A copy of the current Exhibitors Handbook may be downloaded free from the NADAC web site: www.nadac.com
- Bitches in heat, lame, or blind dogs are ineligible for entry, as is any dog with a deformity which may cause a judge to not be able to reasonably assess the dog's ability to function and perform agility obstacles safely, and in a manner that is in the best interest, health and welfare of the dog.
- No food, clickers, or other aids or devices shall be permitted on the course or within 10 feet of the ring. Food or a small non-audible toy can be in a secure container (zip-lock bag is acceptable) in your pocket during your run but you cannot indicate to the dog it is there. All handlers may bring a non-audible toy into the ring for training purposes. They cannot earn a Qualifying score and must declare to the judge they are training before they commence their run. Please read the Exhibitor's Handbook for more information about toys and training in the ring.
- The sponsoring clubs will not be responsible for the loss or damage to any dog exhibited, or for the possessions of any exhibitor whether the result be accident or other cause. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this event is in the care and control of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises.

AGREEMENT

The person who signs this agreement represents that he/she is authorized to enter into this agreement on behalf of both exhibitor and the owner of entered dog. In consideration of acceptance of this entry:

- 1.1 As used here "NADAC" means the North American Dog Agility Council, LLC., its members, officers, directors, employees, show chairs, show committees and agents.
- 1.2 Exhibitor/owner agree to abide by the rules and regulations of NADAC and any other rules and regulations appearing in the premium for this event.
- 1.3 Exhibitor/owner certify that the entered dog is not a hazard to persons, dogs or property and that the entered dog's rabies vaccination is current in accordance with the requirement of the state in which the dog resides.
- 1.4 Exhibitor/owner acknowledge all hazards presented by the event and the event premises, including, but not limited to, the condition of the surface, restrooms, security measures or lack of, electrical appliances, fittings, show rings, parking areas and the presence of unfamiliar animals and people; exhibitor and owner assume the risk of any harm arising from these.
- 1.5 Exhibitor/owner releases NADAC (including its respective officers, directors, employees, and members), [Austin K9 Xpress](#) (including its officers, directors, members, and event organizing committee), and [Dripping Springs Ranch Park](#) (including its officers, agents, and employees) and will defend them and hold them harmless from all present and future loss, injury, damage, claims, demands and liabilities involving the entered dog, the event or event premises. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing, hold harmless provisions, exhibitor/owner hereby specifically assumes sole responsibility for and agrees to indemnify and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expenses (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damages because of bodily injuries, including death, at any time in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, howsoever such injury or death may be caused and whether or not the same may have been caused or may have been alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents or any other persons

Please check all information on your trial confirmation as soon as you receive it, including your dog's NADAC registration number. You should report any errors to the trial secretary immediately. (Kim Galusha at leverage1114@gmail.com)

Also, please check posted results at the trial and report any problems as soon as possible.

DOUBLE RUN FORMAT: We will run the same course twice.

For example: Elite Jumpers will walk, then run both Round 1 and Round 2 (running the same course). We then build Open Jumpers, walk Open Jumpers and run both Round 1 and Round 2 (running the same course). And so on, with Novice and Intro.

CATEGORIES

Each class will be split into two categories, **Proficient** and **Skilled**.

A dog may only be entered in **ONE** category per weekend trial. In the Proficient Category, dogs must jump their measured jump height per the current jump height table. In the Skilled Category, exhibitors **MUST** jump their dog one jump height lower than they are required to jump in the Proficient Category.

INTRO CLASSES:

The Intro level will be a shorter course than Novice. The only Intro level class with weaves will be Intro Weavers and it will have one set of 6 poles. No other classes will have weaves in them. The Intro level will have no tunnel/contact discriminations. The Intro level is a full titling level with the basic titles at 30 points, Outstanding Performance at 60 points (100 points for Regular) and Superior Performance at 100 points (200 points for Regular). In Intro, dogs may jump any jump height lower than their regulation height. Dogs may **NOT** jump higher than their regulation height, and the Maximum Jump height for intro is 16". There is no intro class in Gamblers. You do **NOT** have to start in Intro, you can start your dog's NADAC career in Novice! (Please see NADAC Rule Book for Grandfathering to a higher level)

VETERAN OR DISABLED HANDLER:

Disabled handlers or handlers aged 60 years or older may opt to enter as a Veteran Handler and receive additional standard course time and the dog must jump 4" lower than their standard division height in the VH division. This division is for handlers only. When entering as a Veteran/Disabled Handler, you must enter all classes and all your dogs in this division for the weekend.

VETERAN DOGS:

For dogs, the veteran level is open to any dog age seven (7) years of age or older. The dog's age shall be determined by the dog's actual birthday, or the closest date, as known. Dogs must enter the Veteran Division after their 9th birthday. Dogs in this division are given the allocated Veteran course times. After their 12th birthday dogs must enter the Skilled Category, Veteran Division.

JUNIOR HANDLER DIVISION:

The Junior Handler division is open to any dog which is being handled by a handler who is 17 years of age or younger. Dogs in this division are given the allocated Junior Handler standard course time.

COMBINED POINTS:

At all levels, points from all divisions are combined for titling purposes, and there is no distinction between the divisions. So, a dog may earn some points from the Standard division and some from the Veterans/VH/JH division and all points will be combined for titles and awards.

FOOD/TOYS IN POCKET:

Food or a small noiseless toy may be carried into the ring in your pocket provided it is contained in a zip lock bag or small container such as a pill bottle. The container cannot be visible in the ring nor within 10 feet of the ring. You cannot indicate to your dog that you have this item on you i.e. patting your pocket. You are not allowed to remove the container until you are at least 10 feet outside the ring. All food and toys must be contained at the trial and none can be left lying about loose. This policy has been implemented to reduce the possibility of dogs fighting over loose food or toys, diminish dogs dragging their handlers back to their crates (or wherever they left their food), and to reduce the number of insects that gather around loose food.

AWARD CELEBRATION BARS

WILL BE AWARDED FOR: NATCH, V-NATCH and Platinum NATCH.

One bar per dog at this trial.

We can add multiple titles to the bar if more than one title is won at our trial.
