Refunds:

There shall be no refunds for entries withdrawn after the Closing Date or in the event a dog and/or handler are dismissed from competition, regardless of the reason for such dismissal. Exception: Refunds (less fees incurred) may be given for a dog that suffers an injury or illness or bitches that come into heat after the Closing Date. Requests for refunds must be received in writing (including documentation from a veterinarian for injury or illness) by the Trial Secretary by 5:00 PM the day before the start of the trial.

Confirmations:

Confirmations will be sent by email. Please check your trial confirmation as soon as you receive it. Verify your dog's NADAC registration number and the accuracy of the entry for Division, Jump Height, Classes, etc. Report any errors to the Trial Secretary as soon as possible.

Food info:

There is no food concession on site. Snacks, lunch and water will be provided for volunteers. There are many fast food restaurants nearby.

Volunteer info:

There will be a white board to sign-up to volunteer.

Awards and Ribbons:

Placements ribbons will be awarded to at least fourth place in each jump height for each class, in each category, except Chances which is a pass/fail class. A purple qualifying ribbon shall be given for each qualifying round in each class. There will also be title ribbons available for those earning a new title. NATCH rosettes will be awarded to any dog earning their NATCH, Versatility NATCH, or Platinum NATCH at this trial. Please notify the trial secretary if you expect to earn a NATCH, Versatility NATCH or Platinum NATCH at this trial.

JUMP HEIGHTS

There are four Standard Division-Proficient jump heights: 8", 12", 16", and 20".

There are four Standard Division-Skilled jump heights: 4", 8", 12", and 16".

There are four jump heights for the Veterans and Junior Handler divisions: 4", 8", 12", and 16".

Brief Summary of Rules:

Please refer to www.nadac.com for a full explanation of all NADAC rules and up to date information.

- Please note that NADAC trials should provide a safe and fun environment for both exhibitors and their dogs.
- Aggressive dogs will not be tolerated and will be excused from the trial.
- The show committee has the right to refuse any entry. Anyone not currently in good standing with NADAC will not be allowed to enter this trial.
- Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of NADAC rules and regulations, and agree to abide by all rules in effect at the time of this trial.
- No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reasons of riots, civil disturbances, fire, acts of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- Checks not honored by the bank do not constitute a valid entry fee. There will be a \$25.00 service charge for bank returned checks.
- Dog must be registered and have a valid registration number before entries will be accepted. <https://www.nadac.com/register-your-dog/>
- A copy of the current Exhibitors Handbook may be downloaded free from the NADAC web site: www.nadac.com
- Bitches in heat, lame, or blind dogs are ineligible for entry, as is any dog with a deformity which may cause a judge to not be able to reasonably assess the dog's ability to function and perform agility obstacles safely, and in a manner that is in the best interest, health and welfare of the dog.
- No food, clickers, or other aids or devices shall be permitted on the course or within 10 feet of the ring. Food or a small non-audible toy can be in a secure container (ziplock bag is acceptable) in your pocket during your run but you cannot indicate to the dog it is there. All handlers may bring a non-audible toy into the ring for training purposes. They cannot earn a Qualifying score and must declare to the judge they are training before they commence their run. Please read the Exhibitor's Handbook for more information about toys and training in the ring.
- The sponsoring clubs will not be responsible for the loss or damage to any dog exhibited, or for the possessions of any exhibitor whether the result be accident or other cause. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this event is in the care and control of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises.

AGREEMENT

The person who signs this agreement represents that he/she is authorized to enter into this agreement on behalf of both exhibitor and the owner of entered dog. In consideration of acceptance of this entry:

1.1. As used here "NADAC" means the North American Dog Agility Council, LLC., its members, officers, directors, employees, show chairs, show committees and agents.

1.2. Exhibitor/owner agree to abide by the rules and regulations of NADAC and any other rules and regulations appearing in the premium for this event.

1.3. Exhibitor/owner certify that the entered dog is not a hazard to persons, dogs or property and that the entered dog's rabies vaccination is current in accordance with the requirement of the state in which the dog resides.

1.4. Exhibitor/owner acknowledge all hazards presented by the event and the event premises, including, but not limited to, the condition of the surface, restrooms, security measures or lack of, electrical appliances, fittings, show rings, parking areas and the presence of unfamiliar animals and people; exhibitor and owner assume the risk of any harm arising from these.

1.5. Exhibitor/owner releases NADAC (including its respective officers, directors, employees, and members), Boise Agility Runners and Climbers (including its officers, directors, members, and event organizing committee), and Canyon County Fairgrounds (including its officers, agents, and employees) and will defend them and hold them harmless from all present and future loss, injury, damage, claims, demands and liabilities involving the entered dog, the event or event premises. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing, hold harmless provisions, exhibitor/owner hereby specifically assumes sole responsibility for and agrees to indemnify and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expenses (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damages because of bodily injuries, including death, at any time in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, howsoever such injury or death may be caused and whether or not the same may have been caused or may have been alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents or any other persons

If coming from the east (Boise) on I-84 take Exit 29. Turn left at the traffic light and go over the freeway. After 0.4 miles the road curves to the left and becomes 21st Ave. You will see signs for Fairgrounds, airport, and College of Idaho. Proceed about ¾ of a mile. Immediately after the railroad tracks, turn left on Stock Trail Road. Proceed about 400 feet. Turn right on S 22nd Ave. The Canyon County Fair building is on the left. It is a big, yellow building.

From the east (Boise) via Highway 20/26 (Chinden Blvd.), proceed west about 15 miles from Eagle Road. Chinden turns into Franklin Road in Caldwell. Go over the freeway (I-84) and proceed as above.

From the west, take Highway 20/26 (Bend area) to I-84, or I-84 from Yakima, Portland, etc. Get off at Exit 29. At the traffic light, turn right and proceed as above.
