Dogs cannot be officially measured before 2 years old but, must be measured by the time they are competing in Elite.

JUMP HEIGHTS

There are four Standard Division-Proficient jump heights: 8", 12", 16", and 20".

There are four Standard Division-Skilled jump heights: 4", 8", 12", and 16".

There are four jump heights for the Veterans and Junior Handler divisions: 4", 8", 12", and 16".

Brief Summary of Rules:

Please refer to www.nadac.com for a full explanation of all NADAC rules and up to date information.

- Please note that NADAC trials should provide a safe and fun environment for both exhibitors and their dogs.
- Aggressive dogs will not be tolerated and will be excused from the trial.
- The show committee has the right to refuse any entry. Anyone not currently in good standing with NADAC will not be allowed to enter this trial.
- Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of NADAC rules and regulations, and agree to abide by all rules in effect at the time of this trial.
- No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reasons of riots, civil disturbances, fire, acts of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- Checks not honored by the bank do not constitute a valid entry fee. There will be a \$25.00 service charge for bank returned checks.
- Dog must be registered and have a valid registration number before entries will be accepted. <https://www.nadac.com/register-your-dog/> A copy of the current Exhibitors Handbook may be downloaded free from the NADAC web site: www.nadac.com
- Bitches in heat, lame, or blind dogs are ineligible for entry, as is any dog with a deformity which may cause a judge to not be able to reasonably assess the dog's ability to function and perform agility obstacles safely, and in a manner that is in the best interest, health and welfare of the dog.
- No food, clickers, or other aids or devices shall be permitted on the course or within 10 feet of the ring. Food or a small non-audible toy can be in a secure container (ziplock bag is acceptable) in your pocket during your run but you cannot indicate to the dog it is there. All handlers may bring a non-audible toy into the ring for training purposes. They cannot earn a Qualifying score and must declare to the judge they are training before they commence their run. Please read the Exhibitor's Handbook for more information about toys and training in the ring.
- The sponsoring clubs will not be responsible for the loss or damage to any dog exhibited, or for the possessions of any exhibitor whether the result be accident or other cause. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this event is in the care and control of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises.

AGREEMENT

The person who signs this agreement represents that he/she is authorized to enter into this agreement on behalf of both exhibitor and the owner of entered dog. In consideration of acceptance of this entry:

1.1. As used here "NADAC" means the North American Dog Agility Council, LLC., its members, officers, directors, employees, show chairs, show committees and agents.

1.2. Exhibitor/owner agree to abide by the rules and regulations of NADAC and any other rules and regulations appearing in the premium for this event.

1.3. Exhibitor/owner certify that the entered dog is not a hazard to persons, dogs or property and that the entered dog's rabies vaccination is current in accordance with the requirement of the state in which the dog resides.

1.4. Exhibitor/owner acknowledge all hazards presented by the event and the event premises, including, but not limited to, the condition of the surface, restrooms, security measures or lack of, electrical appliances, fittings, show rings, parking areas and the presence of unfamiliar animals and people; exhibitor and owner assume the risk of any harm arising from these.

1.5. Exhibitor/owner releases NADAC (including its respective officers, directors, employees, and members), NADAC (including its officers, directors, members, and event organizing committee), and Benton County Fairgrounds (including its officers, agents, and employees) and will defend them and hold them harmless from all present and future loss, injury, damage, claims, demands and liabilities involving the entered dog, the event or event premises. DIRECTIONS TO TRIAL SITE:

GPS will find this as Pampered Pets Dog Boarding 130 Norris Road Helena, MT 59602

Once you turn into the boarding kennel parking lot – turn right and follow the road through the little field and parking is alongside the arena.

Directions from I-15 North or South

Take the Lincoln Road Exit – about 5 miles north of Helena. Turn west onto Lincoln Road after you get off the interstate. Go past Bob's Valley Market through the round about. Keep on Lincoln Road until you come to another round about which is Green Meadow and take the 3rd exit out so you will be heading south on Green Meadow, after about 2 miles, you will see the arena from Green Meadow and there is a Pampered Pets Dog Boarding sign on the corner. You will turn right onto Norris Road – you will be turning onto dirt. We are the first drive on the right. Once you turn into the boarding kennel parking lot – turn right and follow the road through the little field and parking is alongside the arena.

Coming in from Townsend, Bozeman, Billings, Butte it is fastest. To avoid town, get on I-15 North and follow I-15 instructions from there.

Coming in from Missoula or West

Once you get into Helena – turn left on Henderson towards the fairgrounds.

Please note: there is a 14 foot bridge this way so if you are bringing a bigger RV or Motor home text or e-mail Trial Chair for alternate directions.

Take Henderson to the end and just before the fairgrounds turn right onto Custer. At the first stop light turn left onto Green Meadow. At about 3 miles you will come to a blinking red light – stay straight on Green Meadow for another mile. You will see the arena from Green Meadow and there is a Pampered Pets Dog Boarding sign on the corner. You will turn left onto Norris Road – you will be turning onto dirt. We are the first drive on the right. Once you turn into the boarding kennel parking lot – turn right and follow the road through the little field and parking is alongside the arena.

Coming from Helena

Take Montana to Custer and head west toward the fairgrounds. Turn right onto Green Meadow and head north. At about 3 miles you will come to a blinking red light – stay straight on Green Meadow for another mile. You will see the arena from Green Meadow and there is a Pampered Pets Dog Boarding sign on the corner. You will turn left onto Norris Road – you will be turning onto dirt. We are the first drive on the right. Once you turn into the boarding kennel parking lot – turn right and follow the road through the little field and parking is alongside the arena.
