Dogs cannot be officially measured before 2 years old but, must be measured by the time they are competing in Elite.

## **JUMP HEIGHTS**

There are four Standard Division-Proficient jump heights: 8", 12", 16", and 20". There are four Standard Division-Skilled jump heights: 4", 8", 12", and 16". There are four jump heights for the Veterans and Junior Handler divisions: 4", 8", 12", and 16". 16" is the highest a dog entered in Intro may jump. ## **Brief Summary of Rules:**

- Please note that NADAC trials should provide a safe and fun environment for both exhibitors and their dogs.
- Aggressive dogs will not be tolerated and will be excused from the trial.
- The show committee has the right to refuse any entry. Anyone not currently in good standing with NADAC will not be allowed to enter this trial.
- Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of NADAC rules and regulations, and agree to abide by all rules in effect at the time of this trial.
- No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reasons of riots, civil disturbances, fire, acts of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
  - Checks not honored by the bank do not constitute a valid entry fee. There will be a \$25.00 service charge for bank returned checks.
- Dog must be registered and have a valid registration number before entries will be accepted. <https://www.nadac.com/register-your-dog/>
- A copy of the current Exhibitors Handbook may be downloaded free from the NADAC web site: [www.nadac.com](http://www.nadac.com) • Bitches in heat, lame, or blind dogs are ineligible for entry, as is any dog with a deformity which may cause a judge to not be able to reasonably assess the dog's ability to function and perform agility obstacles safely, and in a manner that is in the best interest, health and welfare of the dog.
- No food, clickers, or other aids or devices shall be permitted on the course or within 10 feet of the ring. Food or a small non-audible toy can be in a secure container (zip-lock bag is acceptable) in your pocket during your run but you cannot indicate to the dog it is there. All handlers may bring a non-audible toy into the ring for training purposes. They cannot earn a Qualifying score and must declare to the judge they are training before they commence their run. Please read the Exhibitor's Handbook for more information about toys and training in the ring.

## **AGREEMENT**

The person who signs the entry found on the previous page represents that he/she is authorized to enter into this agreement on behalf of both exhibitor and the owner of entered dog. In consideration of acceptance of this entry:

1.1. As used here "NADAC" means the North American Dog Agility Council, LLC., its members, officers, directors, employees, show chairs, show committees and agents.

1.2. Exhibitor/owner agree to abide by the rules and regulations of NADAC and any other rules and regulations appearing in the premium for this event.

1.3. Exhibitor/owner certify that the entered dog is not a hazard to persons, dogs or property and that the entered dog's rabies vaccination is current in accordance with the requirement of the state in which the dog resides.

1.4. Exhibitor/owner acknowledge all hazards presented by the event and the event premises, including, but not limited to, the condition of the surface, restrooms, security measures or lack of, electrical appliances, fittings, show rings, parking areas and the presence of unfamiliar animals and people; exhibitor and owner assume the risk of any harm arising from these.

1.5. Exhibitor/owner releases NADAC (including its respective officers, directors, employees, and members), SchaSam Agility Group, (including its officers, directors, members, and event organizing committee), and SchaSam Farm (including its officers, agents, and employees) and will defend them and hold them harmless from all present and future loss, injury, damage, claims, demands and liabilities involving the entered dog, the event or event premises. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing, hold harmless provisions, exhibitor/owner hereby specifically assumes sole responsibility for and agrees to indemnify and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expenses (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damages because of bodily injuries, including death, at any time in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, howsoever such injury or death may be caused and whether or not the same may have been caused or may have been alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents or any other persons

## Overnight Camping at SchaSam Farm or SchaSam Feld

Dry camping (no electric or water) in the parking pasture for smaller RVs (less than 35'), cars and tents at SchaSam Farm. Electricity may be available via 110 power and extension cords at the Farm. Dry camping with electric (four hookups) at SchaSam Feld – 15 minutes from the trial site.

Porta Potties, water and handwash stations on each site. Showers can be arranged at both locations – ask Sam. There is NO dump station at either site however there is a FREE Washington State dump station at the rest stop just 5 miles south on I5. If you run your generator, please be considerate of our neighbors and other campers and comply with the quiet hours of 10pm to 6:30am both at the Farm and the Feld.

Costs are \$25 per night for electric and \$10 a night for dry. **If you volunteer for at least 5 classes during the weekend, your camping fee is waived.** Camping fees are refundable if you notify Sam before the start day of the trial. No refund after the trial date.

Please let the Trial Chair ([nazbel21@gmail.com](mailto:nazbel21@gmail.com)) know if you are coming with an RV, type (motorhome, trailer or tent), arrival day/time and what you want (dry or power). Make checks payable to SchaSam Farm, enclose with your entry or bring to the trial and turn in at the Info Desk.

**FARM ENVIRONMENT:** These trials are held at a working hobby farm. There are goats, sheep, and sometimes a wandering neighborhood peacock on site. The trial site is about 2 miles from a shotgun firing range that regularly shoots on Tuesday and Sunday but can host events any day of the week. There will be distractions. We WILL follow all current rules for a Washington State Agricultural event. If you don't want to follow the rules or deal with the distractions, please do not enter this competition. Please volunteer and be courteous to our volunteers. We put on these competitions to have fun with our dogs. Please make that your goal as well.

**FUN:** Santa Ducks! There will be numerous rubber duckies (dressed in their finest Santa outfits) hidden around the farm (parking lot, crating/seating areas, barns, and common areas) – find them and bring them to the Info Tent each day for a chance at a great prize!!!

**RIBBON BUY BACK.** . Our July SAG trial ribbon buyback program will go to Toys for Tots. This program provides a free toy shopping opportunity for local families in need. The money raised here will help them provide for more toys for this year's Christmas. The ribbon buyback is where instead of taking a ribbon (Q or placement), you forego that ribbon and SAG provides that cost to the designated charity. There will be little forms to fill out at the trial on the ribbon table. Daily or at the end of the trial you can fill out the form telling SAG how many ribbons (flats) you didn't take and SAG will send a check Toys for Tots program.

**Got any extra agility or rally equipment taking up space? Want to do a good deed for a local 4H club?** Bring it with you to this trial and or drop it off anytime at SchaSam Farm. 4H generally uses AKC equipment – they especially need a tire jump, a wait table, dog walk, standard, triple or broad jumps, tunnels and tunnel bags. Anything is appreciated!

**Overpaid/Scratched Runs?** And as we do every trial - if you overpaid on your entry or you had to scratch some runs, you will be asked if you want to be reimbursed or donate that \$\$ to one of our local 4H clubs.

- 7. Sunday Get ugly: ugly sweater contest – two legged and four legged teammates may compete (or just one). Thrift shops have something to make us all cringe – find it!**
- 8. Try some distance for a good cause: Sam will donate \$5 to Toys for Tots for every team who’s handler stays in the distance challenge box for the entire course (Q or not).**
- 9. Buy some raffle tickets or bid on silent auction items: We will have numerous raffle and silent auction items. Got something to donate? Bring it on Friday and we will draw for the items on Sunday. Need not be present to win!**
- 10. Say Cheese: have your team photo taken at our amazing photo opportunity.**
